Octagon Films was established in 2002 and is a registered charity. Charity Number 1133139

Octagon Films is a community cinema and anyone may apply for membership. Non members can also buy tickets for film showings and live broadcasts.

Club Details

The venue for film showings by Octagon Films is at the Harborough Theatre, Church Square. This venue has over 100 tiered seats in an air conditioned auditorium and has a high quality screen and digital projection facilities. It has Dolby surround sound (12 loudspeakers) and an induction loop is installed to assist members with hearing aids. The theatre has a separate bar and lounge area where members can enjoy a drink before during and after they watch the film or live broadcast which will help to make cinema evenings an informal and enjoyable community event. The central town location of the theatre means that there is plenty of parking nearby.

Octagon members can buy tickets for both films and live broadcasts in advance from **Quinns Bookshop**, Three Crowns Yard, off the High Street between Joules & Andrew Granger Mon – Tue: 10:00 – 16.00hrs, Thu - Sat: 10.00 – 16.00hrs (closed Wed, Sun). You can pay by cash or cheque (made payable to Octagon Films). **Tickets may also be bought on-line** for films and live broadcasts by visiting Octagon's website. Alternatively, members can obtain tickets 45 minutes before the start of a film performance and a live broadcast at the venue. Membership cards must be shown when purchasing tickets for film showings and live broadcasts to gain the member's discount rate.. You can pay by cash or cheque (made payable to Octagon Films).

Thirty or more films and about 30 live broadcasts are shown each year and members will receive a programme for both approximately every 7 weeks which gives details of the actors & a short description of the films and live shows. **The main showing night is a Friday** for films but films can also be shown on a Saturday and Sunday. Live broadcasts are normally shown on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

Ticket Prices: Films: Non-members, £7.00, Members, £5.00. Under 18s: £4.00. . Live Broadcasts: NT Live, The Bolshoi and The RSC: Non members, £13, members, £11, 18's and under, £8. Royal Opera House, Non members, £15, members £13

Programmes are issued electronically, so do include your e-mail address in the application form.

Young Person: For members aged 12 - 17 years . Fee: **£8.00 for two years**. Each member is allowed to bring one guest to a film show.

Adult: For members aged 18 years and older. Fee: **£12.00 for two years**. Each adult member is allowed to bring one guest to a film show.

Family: For up to 2 adults and nominated children (under the age of 18) who are living at the same address. Fee: **£24.00 for two years**. **A family is allowed to bring a maximum number of guests equal to the total of family members shown on the membership card.**
